Also present – Amanda Welch, Waupaca County Personnel Director, Diane Meulemans, Waupaca County Corporation Counsel, Mark Korth, Equipment and Facility Superintendent, Lance Penney, Interim Highway Commissioner, and Jill Lodewegen, Highway Office Specialist

Mrs. Welch discussed with the committee the time frame of the open Highway Commissioner position. She noted that applications were due January 22 and that she had received about 5 so far. She will try to schedule interviews the first week of February. Mrs. Welch then left the meeting.

The second one for Hatton Road with an estimated replacement cost of \$259,800 which will be 80% federally funded. The town is requesting 50% County Bridge aide for their 20% estimated cost of \$51,960.
