WAUPACA COUNTY HIGHWAY SPECIAL BUILDING COMMITTEE MINUTES

December 2, 2016

Chair Dick Koeppen called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and confirmed the open meeting law requirements were met.

Review and approve minutes – November 3, 2016. **Motion**: Supr. Barrington moved and Supr. Sorensen seconded the motion to approve the previous minutes. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Highway Commissioner Casey Beyersdorf gave a general guideline for the interview process and noted the interview question and rating sheets that were handed out to each member.
