Fiber Discussion with Manawa School District/Wiscnet/MC&E – R. Reath reported that Wiscnet approached Joel Mckulsky from MC&E about the possibility of the school district laying fiber towards the Sheriff Department Annex in Manawa to connect up with the County's fiber. A. Carlin discussed future expansion of the fiber towards the Symco tower and the need for this to occur. This discussion is in an information gathering stage.

2015 Budget – Final Report – R. Reath handed out the final 2015 budget figures for both the Information Systems operating budget and the 2015 IT Technology Maintenance budget. There is a surplus of \$95,148.60 resulting mainly from employee changes. The IT Technology 2015 budget surplus of \$59,719.93 will automatically roll over into the 2016 budget. Discussion followed.
