Lakeview Manor Update – B. Wyland reported that the IT Department worked with Renae Connery, Purchasing/Asset Manager to coordinate the removal of computer related equipment to include server, switches, Shoretel phone system, etc. This equipment will be put in the IT inventory and reused. Discussion followed.

Spectrum Communications Outage – B.Wyland reported on the Spectrum communications outage that occurred during April which affected the East Central region. Discussion followed.

IT Department – Window Treatments – B. Wyland reported that he is working with A. Carlin, Emergency Management, on securing the IT department in the event of a safety or security situation. B. Wyland will be obtaining costs on different types of window treatments to be used on all windows in the IT department. The IT Committee will tour the IT department during next month's meeting to view the windows within the department and

discuss the window treatments that are available to make them more secure during a crisis. Discussion followed.
