

LAW ENFORCEMENT MEETING

12 May 2015

The Waupaca County Law Enforcement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Jonely. Members present: Supervisors Craig, Handrich, Johnson, and Wilfuer. Others present: Sheriff Hardel, Chief Deputy Kraeger, Captain Conat, Captain Wilz, Captain Rasmussen, Captain Wogsland, Lt. Jason Russell and County Board Chairman Dick Koeppen.

Chairman Jonely gave the opening meeting statement that this meeting and all other meetings of this Committee are open to the public. Proper notice has been posted and given to the press in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes so that the citizenry may be aware of the time, place and agenda of this meeting.

Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Johnson to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2015 meeting of the Law Enforcement Committee. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Motion by Supervisor Handrich, seconded by Supervisor Wilfuer to approve the agenda. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Johnson to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Captain Wilz reported for the Communication Center that Alex Krueger has passed his probationary period. Amanda Zastrow resigned her position, which will leave two positions to fill this fall. A new computer and server will be needed for the digital recording system.

Captain Wogsland reported that nine air pack systems are needed, but we'll be able to get by with seven. Inmate shower systems need to be looked at. A possibility would be to clean and re-grout or look at stainless steel units. The new jail cameras have been installed. Alyssa Eake will start on May 27.

Captain Conat reported that Sgt. Krueger is doing an internal investigation for another county, Sgt. Gorman assisted Manawa Police Department with a case and Sgts Moadlo and Thobaben are assisting with an in-county investigation.

Captain Rasmussen reported on Patrol division statistics. Supervisor Johnson moved, Supervisor Handrich second to approve the report. Motion carried without a negative vote. The patrol report was placed on file.

Sheriff's Office report was presented by Chief Deputy Kraeger. Motion to approve the report by Supervisor Handrich, second by Supervisor Wilfuer. Motion carried without a negative vote. The sheriff's report was placed on file.

Sheriff Hardel reported that our two new drug officers have been very busy. The SWAT team assisted them last week with a drug related arrest and confiscation of drugs. A motion was made by Supervisor Craig, second by Supervisor Johnson to approve the dance hall permit application from Nature's Edge and two events for Randy Steingraber, one on June 18-21, 2015 and the other on July 10-12, 2015. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Supervisor Handrich moved, second by Supervisor Wilfuer to adjourn at 10:12 a.m. Motion carried.
