

LAW ENFORCEMENT MEETING

9 June 2015

The Waupaca County Law Enforcement Committee was called to order at 9:08 a.m. by Chairman Jonely. Members present: Supervisors Craig, Handrich, Johnson, and Wilfuer. Others present: Sheriff Hardel, Captain Conat, Captain Rasmussen, Captain Wogsland and County Board Chairman Dick Koeppen.

Chairman Jonely gave the opening meeting statement that this meeting and all other meetings of this Committee are open to the public. Proper notice has been posted and given to the press in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes so that the citizenry may be aware of the time, place and agenda of this meeting.

Motion by Supervisor Johnson, seconded by Supervisor Handrich to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2015 meeting of the Law Enforcement Committee. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Handrich to approve the agenda. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Motion by Supervisor Handrich, seconded by Supervisor Craig to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Sheriff Hardel reported for the Communication Center that there are currently two individuals in training and both are doing well.

Captain Wogsland reported that recent interviews went well with some very qualified individuals. Alyssa Eake started on May 27.

Captain Conat reported that Sgt. Gorman is working with the arrest of an illegal alien, Sgts Gorman and Thobaben continue to assist Fremont PD with their homicide investigation and Sgt. Mocadlo is conducting an in-county investigation.

Captain Rasmussen reported on Patrol division statistics. Supervisor Johnson moved, Supervisor Wilfuer second to approve the report. Motion carried without a negative vote. The patrol report was placed on file. Transport Officer Shane Bazile is on light-duty after surgery and is working to clear up old evidence.

Sheriff's Office report was presented by Sheriff Hardel. Motion to approve the report by Supervisor Wilfuer, second by Supervisor Handrich. Motion carried without a negative vote. The sheriff's report was placed on file.

Sheriff Hardel reported that he, Chief Deputy Kraeger and two Sgts. attended the Badger State Conference, which was excellent. The theme was ethical leadership and training.

Captain Rasmussen and Sheriff Hardel reported on an available Federal COPS Grant which would pay for 75% of two officers for three years. Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Johnson to approve the submission of the grant application and send the same to the Finance Committee for their approval. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Supervisor Craig moved, second by Supervisor Handrich to adjourn at 10:23 a.m. Motion carried.
