LAW ENFORCEMENT MEETING 09 February 2016

Captain Conat reported for the Detective Division that the Department of Justice is assisting with the double homicide case.

Captain Rasmussen reported on Patrol Division statistics. Supervisor Handrich moved, Supervisor Wilfuer second to approve the report. Motion carried without a negative vote. The patrol report was placed on file. Captain Rasmussen also reported that Kyle Wiskirchen has started as a new patrol officer to fill Cameron Durrant's position that was vacated when he accepted a detective position.
