

LAW ENFORCEMENT MEETING

The Waupaca County Law Enforcement Committee was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Jonely. Members present: Supervisors Craig, Handrich, Wilfuer, Poehlman and Board Chair Koeppen. Others present: Chief Deputy Kraeger, Captain Conat, Captain Wilz, Captain Rasmussen and Lt. Russell.

Chairman Jonely gave the opening meeting statement that this meeting and all other meetings of this Committee are open to the public. Proper notice has been posted and given to the press in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes so that the citizenry may be aware of the time, place and agenda of this meeting.

Motion by Supervisor Wilfuer, seconded by Supervisor Poehlman to approve the minutes of the May 9, 2016 meeting of the Law Enforcement Committee. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Handrich to approve the agenda. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Handrich to approve the May bills as presented. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Captain Wilz reported for the Communication Center that this weekend had been very busy due to the storms. Det. Sgt. Rob Karski has been selected to replace Captain Wilz as the head of the Communication Center. Caller ID should be working by the end of the month. Captain Wilz thanked the committee for the 31 years he's worked at the Sheriff's Office.

Lt. Russell reported for the Jail that our population in the jail has been high, with numbers averaging 215. Portage County is sending more inmates. A camera has been installed in the nurse's medication room and is up and running.

Captain Conat reported for the Detective Division that they are finishing investigation on the recent homicide. The horse molestation case is on-going.

Captain Rasmussen reported on the Patrol Division statistics. Board Chair Koeppen moved, Supervisor Wilfuer second to approve the report. Motion carried without a negative vote. The patrol report was placed on file.

Sheriff's Office report was presented by Chief Deputy Kraeger. Motion to approve the report by Supervisor Wilfuer, second by Supervisor Poehlman. Motion carried without a negative vote. The Sheriff's Office report was placed on file.

The Sheriff's Report was given by Chief Deputy Kraeger. He said the sheriff will be going to the National Sheriff's Conference in Minnesota. Also, that Captain Wogsland is recuperating from recent surgery. The purchase of an e-referral module from Spillman was discussed. This would enable all reports to be filed electronically with the DA's Office. Also for informational purposes were the particulars of an IBR (Incident Based Reporting) module from Spillman. A life saving award was presented to Captain Don Conat for saving a fisherman.

The agenda item "Protective Service for Corrections" was tabled until the July meeting.

A motion was made by Supervisor Craig, second by Supervisor Wilfuer to approve a one-time dance hall permit for Vintage Pipes & Stripes for June 10 and June 11. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Supervisor Handrich moved, second by Board Chair Koeppen to adjourn at 10:46 a.m. Motion carried.
