

LAW ENFORCEMENT MEETING

The Waupaca County Law Enforcement Committee was called to order at 9:10 a.m. by Chairman Jonely. Members present: Supervisors Craig, Wilfuer and Poehlman. Others present: Sheriff Brad Hardel, Chief Deputy Allen Kraeger, Captain Conat, Captain Karski, Captain Rasmussen, Captain Wogsland and Lt. Russell.

Chairman Jonely gave the opening meeting statement that this meeting and all other meetings of this Committee are open to the public. Proper notice has been posted and given to the press in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes so that the citizenry may be aware of the time, place and agenda of this meeting.

Motion by Supervisor Craig, seconded by Supervisor Poehlman to approve the minutes of the December 13, 2016 meeting of the Law Enforcement Committee. Motion carried without a negative vote.

Captain Karski introduced Meagan Waller, who started in the Communication Center on January 3. Nicole Schuelke will be starting in the Comm Center on January 30, which will make Dispatch fully staffed.

Captain Wogsland reported for the Jail by showing pictures of the completed jail kitchen ceiling project. Stephanie Butzer has been offered a position in Corrections. Some "bugs" with the new camera upgrade are being worked on.

Captain Conat reported for the Detective Division that they are investigating some new child pornography cases. The trial for the Fremont homicide is scheduled for next week. The arson on Worm Road is going to a plea bargain this week.

Captain Rasmussen reported on the Patrol Division statistics. A motion was made by Supervisor Wilfuer, seconded by Supervisor Poehlman to approve the December report. The motion carried without a negative vote. The patrol report was placed on file.

The Sheriff's Office report was then presented by Chief Deputy Kraeger. A motion was made by Supervisor Poehlman, seconded by Supervisor Wilfuer to accept the December report. The motion carried without a negative vote and the report was placed on file.

The Sheriff's Report was given by Sheriff Hardel. He reported that 3-20' evidence containers were recently purchased. They will be placed across from the Manawa Annex. The Sheriff's Office now has jurisdiction of the Waupaca County Courthouse. The Waupaca Police Department is responsible for the area outside of the courthouse building.

Chief Deputy Kraeger reported that one year after implementation of our copier service with EOJohnson, we were able to reduce our monthly charge by approximately \$200.00.

Supervisor Craig moved, second by Supervisor Wilfuer to adjourn at 10:12 a.m. Motion carried.
