The agreement spells out allowable uses and restricted uses. Holman stated the agreement has been given to Sturm for review. Discussion followed on the generous gift, uses for the property, and restrictions.

Motion by McClone, seconded by Wichman to accept the property gift from Lynn Simpson with review by Sturm, the County receiving a lease, and the property to be transferred to the City of Clintonville. Motion carried without a negative vote.
